### ANNOUNCEMENTS

**Update: the roof repair project** has mostly been completed. The roof portion is complete. The roofing company will return to inspect and caulk the windows. We have paid 80% of the bill. 20% plus the HST still has to be paid.

**The next parish council meeting** – will take place on Tuesday, October 13 at 7:30 p.m. via a Zoom meeting.

**The parish residence is undergoing a major interior renovation** paid for by the Basilian Fathers. Among other things, the flooring and the windows are being replaced, the walls are being repainted, some bathroom fixtures and some lighting are being replaced. The kitchen is being renovated (courtesy of Lowe's hardware). The office is being overhauled and will be moved back to where it used to be. Parish council approved putting stucco on the external garage walls and this has already been done. The stucco completes the project Fr. Cyril had begun a few years ago to construct a garage.

**In addition to the residence project, a minor church repair was also carried out.** The parging at the base of the eastern wall of the church kitchen where it runs along the church parking lot has been repaired.

**Thank you to everyone who helped out** by standing in prayerful vigil outside the abortion clinic for **40 DAYS for LIFE** on September 30, 2020. 27 volunteers stepped up from our parish. This is quite gratifying. The prayer vigils will continue every day until November 1 at the south west corner of the intersection of Queen and Bank streets downtown. Different organizations and

individuals will be providing volunteers to conduct the vigil, but sometimes extra people show up spontaneously and pray for a limited time with the volunteers already there. It is ok to do this, but if you go there to add your prayers then please remember to keep social distancing.
